Summary Points

- **v 1 to 9** The LORD tells Ezekiel to prophesy that a very large army from the north will invade the regathered nation of Israel
- **v 10 to 16** The motive of the army is to take Israel's wealth. This is all part of God's purpose
- **v 17 to 23** When the invasion takes place, God will intervene and stop the invasion using natural forces. All nations will then acknowledge the LORD God of Israel (see theme)

A selection of verses showing that the God of the Bible is also the God of Israel.

Moses told Pharaoh that the LORD wanted his people released:

Exodus 5 verse 1

God chose Israel as a special nation through whom he could work:

Deuteronomy 7 verses 6 to 8

Israel's leader, Joshua, reminded the people of their responsibility to their God:

Joshua 24 verse 23

Hezekiah could call on the God of Israel to rescue his people in their time of trouble:

Isaiah 37 verses 15 to 17

The people recognised the hand of God when Jesus healed:

Matthew 15 verse 31
