Questions

1. What will happen to this invading army on the mountains of Israel?
2. How long will it take to cleanse the land?
3. What will the house of Israel and the nations know as a result of the LORD's judgements?



Summary Points

- **v 1 to 8** The northern army will be defeated by the Lord GOD on the mountains of Israel
- **v 9 and 10** It will take seven years to clear up the weapons of war
- **v 11 to 16** There will be a burial ground for all the army of Gog. It will take seven months to complete the burials
- **v 17 to 20** A poetic description of the total destruction of the invader
- **v 21 to 24** The nations will know that Israel suffered because they disobeyed the LORD
- **v 25 to 29** All Israel will be restored and they and all nations will know that the LORD is the only true God (see theme)

Theme

The only true God

A selection of verses showing that the God of the Bible is the only true God.

Through the prophet Isaiah, God challenges the idols to foretell the future as he does:

Isaiah 41 verses 21 to 24

Later in Isaiah's prophecy, God reminds him that he can foretell the future:

Isaiah 42 verse 9

God says that the fact that he has foretold the Jews' history is evidence that he is God:

Isaiah 43 verses 9 to 12

Isaiah 45 verses 20 to 22

Jesus says that our long-term future depends on us knowing the only true God:

John 17 verse 3

The apostle Paul tells the Corinthians that there is one God and one Lord Jesus Christ:

1 Corinthians 8 verse 6
