Questions

1. What does the LORD say about the future of Jerusalem?
2. What does the LORD of Armies say about his people in the east and west countries?
3. How does the LORD want his people to treat their neighbours?



Summary Points

- **v 1 to 8** Jerusalem is the LORD's city and his people will again return to the city and live there
- **v 9 to 15** The LORD encourages the people to be strong and rebuild the temple. They have suffered problems in the past but the LORD will bless them in the future
- **v 16 to 19** The people are to deal well with their neighbours and to pursue truth and peace
- **v 20 to 23** Many peoples and nations will come to worship the LORD in Jerusalem (see theme)
