Summary Points

- **v 1 to 7** John sees a vision of one sitting on a throne with a book in his hand. The only one worthy to open the book and its seven seals is the Lamb (see theme) who takes the book from the one on the throne
- **v 8 to 14** Those in the vision praise the Lamb for his sacrifice, his role as saviour (see theme), and look to his future dominion

Themes

Titles of Jesus - Lamb of God

A selection of verses showing that Jesus is the Lamb of God.

On two occasions, John the Baptist calls Jesus the Lamb of God:

John 1 verse 29

John 1 verse 36

The apostle Philip told the Ethiopian that Isaiah was talking about Jesus Christ when he talked about a lamb:

Acts 8 verses 30 to 35

The apostle Peter talks of Christ as a lamb when talking about his sacrifice:

1 Peter 1 verse 19

Jesus was sacrificed for us

A selection of verses showing that Jesus Christ died for us.

The apostle John and the letter to the Hebrews record several statements about the purpose of Jesus' death:

John 10 verse 11

John 15 verse 13

Hebrews 9 verse 28

Hebrews 10 verse 12

On several occasions believers are encouraged to follow Jesus' example:

Ephesians 5 verse 2

1 John 3 verse 16
