Questions to start you thinking about the chapter - the answers are in verses in the chapter:

2. What conclusion did the magicians offer Pharaoh when they could not produce lice, like God had through Moses?
3. Why couldn't Moses and the Israelites sacrifice to God in Egypt?

Related theme to look at: Advice on living - Recognising the evidence.

A selection of verses showing that we should recognise evidence of God's hand when we see it.

The land of Egypt was being devastated by plagues from God. Pharaoh refused to acknowledge Israel's God was behind the plagues because he wanted to keep the people as slaves:

- Exodus 8 v 30 to 32

Many people recognised the evidence of the miracles that Jesus did:

- John 6 v 2
- John 7 v 31

In the early days of the first-century church, Peter reminded his hearers to recognise that the miracles Jesus did were evidence that he was from God:

- Acts 2 v 22

The prophet Isaiah tells us that the people of Israel are an evidence of the God of the Bible.

He says of the people of Israel:

- Isaiah 43 v 10 to 12
