Related theme verses to look at: Your long-term future - Many will rise from the dead and live forever.

The prophet Daniel speaks of a time when the dead will rise from the grave:

Daniel 12 v 2

The prophet Hosea says that God will raise people from "Sheol" (the place of the dead):

Hosea 13 v 14

Martha, one of Jesus' followers, expresses her belief that her dead brother will rise from the dead. Jesus then tells her that it is through belief in him that we can be raised:

John 11 v 24 - 25

The apostle Paul, when he is on trial makes it clear that he believes in the resurrection of the dead:

> Acts 24 v 14 - 15
