### Romans 5

**Questions** to start you thinking about the chapter - the answers are in verses in the chapter:

1. What is achieved by our faith?
2. What is the important contrast between "the one" (Adam) and Jesus Christ?
3. If sin causes death, what do we need for eternal life?

**Main points** that you see in these sections of the chapter:

v 1 to 5

v 6 to 11

v 12 to 21

**Related theme** to look at: Jesus the Christ - Jesus has enabled our sins to be forgiven.

John the Baptist recognises that Jesus is the one who will enable sins to be forgiven:

- John 1 v 29

At the "last supper" Jesus Christ himself confirms that forgiveness of sins is through him:

- Matthew 26 v 27 and 28

The apostle Paul several times confirms that it is through Jesus Christ that we can have our sins forgiven:

- Romans 5 v 8
- 1 Corinthians 15 v 3
- Ephesians 1 v 7

The apostle Peter gives the same message:

- 1 Peter 2 v 24
