Verses	Questions	Your Notes
1 to 9	Who came to bring the case of the Jews, and what did he accuse Paul of?	Tertullus came to file the Jewish case. He accused Paul of: Corruption Sedition among all Jews being the leader of Christian heresy temple pollution
10 to 13	2. What did Paul say about his recent behaviour in Jerusalem?	Paul said they could not substantiate any of their allegations. He was worshiping in the temple but did not cause any problems.
14 to 22	3. What did Paul confess, and what did he say he believed?	He admitted that he was following a "new path". "Like the Jews, he believed in the law and the prophets, but the real problem was that he believed that the resurrection of the dead would take place," he said.
23	4. What did Felix do after hearing the evidence?	He kept Paul in prison, but allowed his friends to come and see him.
24 to 26	5. What is Felix's next contact with Paul and how did he deal with him later?	A few days later, his Jewish wife, Drusilla, came to listen to Paul. Felix feared talking about God's judgment, but kept him in prison in the hope of receiving a bribe for his release.

27	6. What happened two years later?	Paul remained a prisoner when Felix succeeded Porcius Festus. This pleased the Jews.
